- The Beatles is the most famous group ever. The four Beatles, John Lennon, Paul McCartney, George Harrison and Ringo Starr were all born in Liverpool, England. They started playing together in 1959. They played in many countries in Europe, sometimes for royalty (kings and queens). Lennon told the royals to rattle their jewellery when they liked the song.
- These four played in Britain, the United States of America, Canada, Japan and all through Western Europe. They were so popular that the people crowded around them if they went outside their hotel rooms. They made people laugh and sometimes cry with their songs.
- John Lennon was assassinated in 1980. Paul McCartney is the only member of the band who still sings. A few years ago at the Live 8 concert he sang for millions of people throughout the world. The Live 8 concert was held to collect money for the poor.
- He opened the concert with "Sergeant Pepper's Lonely Heart Club". For the finale he sang "Hey Jude".
