The memorandum indicates that 25 subjects from the Trimester 2 examination cycle will not be released until 16 October 2015.

The following measures have been agreed upon by the different stakeholders.

Students whose results have not been released by 7 September 2015, will be managed as follows:

- Students must register for the relevant outstanding subject(s) on the higher level. Kindly note that this refers to <u>ONLY</u> the 25 outstanding subjects as per the abovementioned memorandum.
- When the outstanding result(s) have been released, and a student has failed a subject, he/she will be given first preference to register for the subject in the first trimester of 2016.
- First preference will be provided for by means of the pre-enrolment process
- Students who have outstanding results and wants to enrol for practical workshop training, may be permitted to do so
